# What do we do?










- Distribute IPv4, IPv6, ASNs

- RIPE Meetings and regional meetings








# RIPE Community

- Not a legal entity and no formal membership
- Develops policies
- Work done in working groups
- Activities are performed on a voluntary basis
- Decisions formed by consensus
- RIPE Meetings twice a year



#### **Policy Development Process**



#### Open

- Anyone can participate
- On mailing lists and at meetings

#### Transparent

- List discussions archived publicly
- Meetings transcribed

#### Developed bottom-up

- YOU make the policies
- The RIPE NCC implements them




#### Participate in the PDP



- Sign up for the Policy Development Process
  Announcements mailing list
  - Join in discussions about policy proposals
  - Stay up-to-date with new policies
  - Propose a new policy

#### Other cases



Disagreement with RIPE NCC's answer to a request
 First: Revision/Escalation

 Changes related to the RIPE NCC membership (e.g. Charging Scheme, Articles of Association)
 Solution: RIPE NCC General Meeting

#### Who Does What?



#### The RIPE community

- Creates and discusses proposals
- Seeks consensus

#### RIPE Working Group (WG) chairs

- Accept proposals
- Chair the discussions
- Decide if consensus has been reached

#### The RIPE NCC

- Acts as the secretariat to support the process
- Publishes policy documents and implements them



# RIPE Meetings

#### What is a RIPE Meeting?



- Five-day event where ISPs, network operators and other interested parties gather to:
  - discuss policies and procedures to allocate IP addresses and ASNs
  - discuss current technical and policy issues
  - share experiences, latest developments and best common practices
  - network with peers.





#### RIPE NCC General Meeting



- Discuss the RIPE NCC operations and activities
- Give feedback on the RIPE NCC Activity Plan and Budget
- Vote on:
  - Charging Scheme
  - Executive Board
  - Financial Report
  - Other resolutions



#### RIPE NCC General Meeting



- It's a separate meeting
- Open to RIPE NCC members only
- Separate registration
- Takes place Wednesday after RIPE NCC Services WG
- Talk to Alex, Alun or Ulka for help in registering

## Great Idea for a Plenary Presentation?




- You can submit a presentation for the RIPE Meeting Plenary
- Will be reviewed by the Programme Committee
- Keep an eye out for the Call for Presentations
  - usually opens six months before the meeting



## Check Out a Birds of a Feather (BoF)




- "Birds of a Feather" people with the same interests gathering to talk about a particular topic/issue
- Takes place at the end of the day
- Ad hoc, informal
- No remote participation
- You can organise one yourself



#### RIPE Meeting Code of Conduct
